

Alvosenet Product Operation Guide

A. Product License

1. Product License

For Non-Web Edition: The product license can be used for installing Alvosenet product on one PC. When the product is first installed or run, the license key will be verified.

For Web Edition: The product license is valid for one year from the date of purchase. When the product license is about to expire, you can extend it for the following year on our website or contact us directly.

2. Free Trial

Alvosenet offers free-trial for a limited period of time. By clicking on the "Free Trial" button, you can download the product and a free-trial license. Once your trial expires, you can upgrade from Free Trial License to Paid License. Please go to Manage Order page and click "Upgrade" button for the Free License Order you want to upgrade.

3. Paid License

Products with paid license can be obtained on alvosenet.com at any time. The product file(s) can be downloaded after the transaction; or from Manage > Order on alvosenet.com and click the "Download" button to download the product file(s) for installation.

4. Site License and Volume Discount

B. Product Package

1. Download Anytime

If you do not download the product file(s) after the transaction, you can download the product file(s) for installation from the Manage > Order page on alvosenet.com and click the

"Download" button.

For Web Edition, only one file will be downloaded. There is no license key for Web Edition.

2. Startup of Product Execution

Alvosenet will start operating automatically when the computer is turned on.

3. Product Package Contents

After the installation, there are two executable files:

(1) Admin.exe: Allows you to select Configuration Options for specific Internet/Web activities and applications that you wish to monitor and block.

Notes: For Web Edition, please go to Manage > Order on alvosenet.com to change Configuration Options, then launch Admin.exe to update the changes.

(2) uninst000.exe: Allow you to uninstall the product.

4. Program File

The default folder for the installed product is as follows:

For Windows 7 and 8.1: C:\Program Files(x86)\Alvosenet

C. Security Report

1. Delivery of Security Report

The Security Report is generated when the computer rebooted or when the computer has been running for over 24 hours.

For Non-Web Edition: The Security Report will be sent to your registered email address, or saved on the local computer.

For Web Edition: The Security Report will be available on alvosenet.com website, or saved on the local computer.

If the report is saved to the local computer, the default folder for the Security Report is "C:\Alvosenet". The frequency of the Security Report depends varies. When the computer is not running or not connected to the Internet, the report will be saved and sent later.

2. Information Provided in Security Report

The Security Report identifies web search texts, URLs of web pages browsed, emails and messages sent, chats and posts, and files captured and matched with Security Keywords. It also indicates the Security Keywords found during the monitored period. In addition, it provides statistics for the activities captured, matched and/or blocked, as well as security status and recommended actions.

3. Amount of Information Provided

The amount of the information provided by the Security Report may be limited by the maximum email size you can receive. The emails and messages included in the Security Report may not be complete due to size restriction and user actions.

D. Configuration Options for Operation

In the Configuration Options, you can select the Internet/Web activities to monitor and/or block, the websites, applications, and file transfer types to block, and when to monitor Internet/Web activities. The Configuration Options is available to be selected during the installation or at a later time.

1. Configuration Options during Installation

In order to better meet your needs, you can customize the Security Report by configuring the options for monitoring, blocking, and accessing of Internet and Web activities as well as the use of Internet and Web applications during the installation. You can change what is monitored for various Internet and Web activities, applications, time frames, etc. Also, specific Internet and Web activities can be selected to block if the activity matches the Security Keywords. If there are any additional features needed for the product, please let us know and we will be happy to discuss any of your requirements with you.

2. Configuration Options during Operation

You can also select or update the Configuration Options after the installation process. To customize the Security Report:

- (1) For Non-Web Edition: Launch the program file "Admin.exe" located in the Program File folder to make changes for the Configuration Options.
- (2) For Web Edition: Login to alvosenet.com, go to Manage > Options to select or update the Configuration Options. Please launch Admin.exe if any of the following options is changed: a) Block search websites, b) Block access to the website for social networks, c) Block access to Instant Messenger, and d) Block application launch.
